She has a strong interest in human rights issues and administrative law, having begun her career at Legal Aid Ontario where she practiced at the intersection of refugee, immigration, and criminal law. She has also taught as a sessional lecture with University of Toronto's Faculty of Medicine's Global Human Rights Education Initiative as well as teaching adjudicators in refugee matters both domestically and internationally.
